Sum, sum, sum, sum, sum, sum
SUMMER TIME!

Well folks, summer is upon us and I surely hope that you have lots of fun things planned...or, perhaps, absolutely nothing at all!

Through much of the recent heat wave (WOW was it *HOT!*) I was off from church duties and working on repairing/rebuilding the deck on Linda's She Shack. All the whilst I was digging, busting up granite bedrock with a sledgehammer, nailing, screwing and reattaching, I had one very strange thought running through my head all the while: Freeze Tag.
