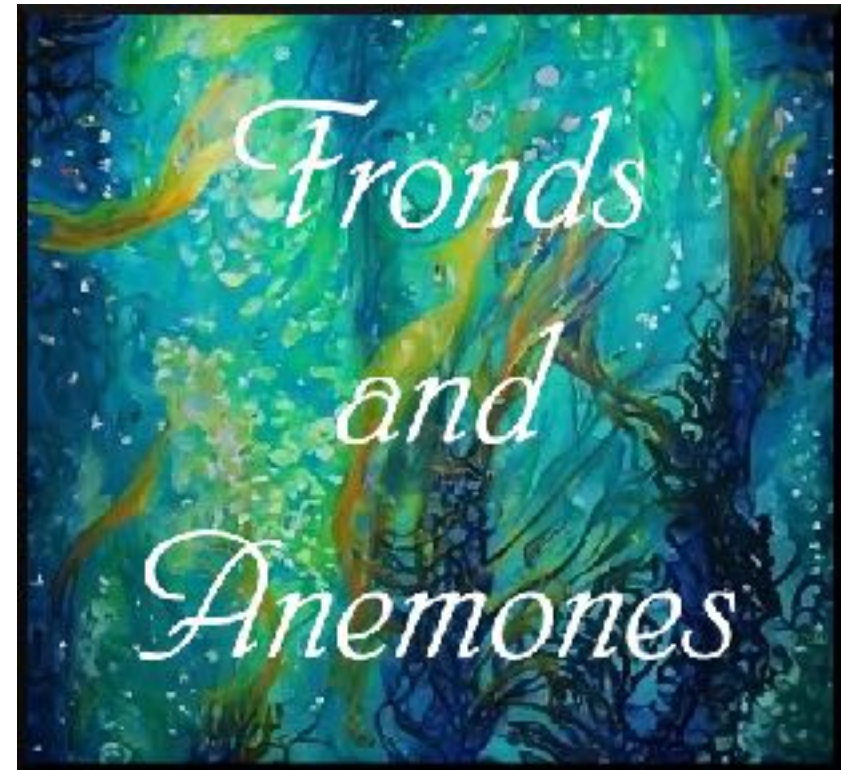
Following the worship service everyone is invited to Fellowship Hall for conversation and a light repast.
