* **PRAYER OF CONFESSION** (Unison)

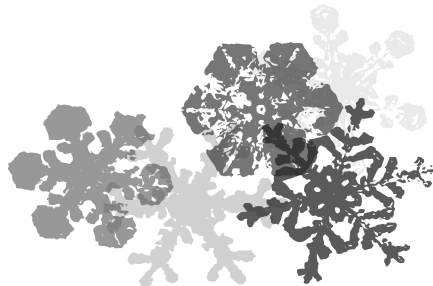
