* PRAYER OF CONFESSION (Unison)

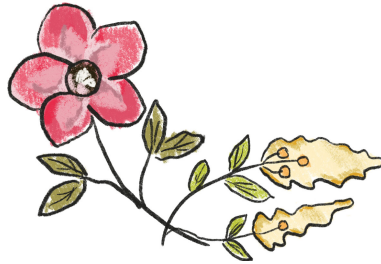
