The Third Sunday of Advent - JOY

Reader 2: As we wait for Christmas, the birth of Jesus, we look forward to the joyful celebrations we will share with those we love. The prophet Zephaniah calls us to shout for joy, because God will gather together all people and renew them in love. When Jesus was born in Bethlehem, the angel told the shepherds not to be afraid. The angels brought "good news of a great joy, which shall be to all people." The good news of Jesus' birth and the promise of Peace are still "tidings of great joy" for us today.

Reader 1: Paul reminds Christians,

"Rejoice in God always." The third candle reminds us of our joy in Jesus Christ.
