Church School and Nursery Care Resumes. Director Andrea Montgomery has an exciting year planned for the kids in Church School, and Emily and Kate Ewy are "super psyched" to welcome babies and toddlers back to the nursery!

Cabbage Roll and Rummage

Update On Sign. We are currently in the process of requesting a "Use Variance" to erect a new sign to replace the existing sign. The matter will be reviewed by the Zoning Board of Appeals at their September 14th meeting (hands clasped and fingers crossed).

Update On Selleck Land/ Youth Group Room. Though we had a buyer lined up for the Selleck land (the proceeds of which are earmarked to pay for the remodeling of the new Youth Group room) we were unable to move ahead with the sale this summer as the appraised value is significantly higher than the agreed upon price (which we believe to be fair). The issue is, any sale of church owned property must be approved by the NYS Supreme Court. Hence we must list the property if only to prove it will not sell for appraised value.

Though not an ideal time (as if one existed) in the life of the church for such an extended leave, this year I will again attempt to embark on a much needed break September 4th through the 24th. I don't necessarily have any major travel plans. Instead, I hope to catch up on little things around the cottage and, primarily, do a lot of nothing to the degree that is possible. Beware Of Scams!

Apparently church folk, given our gracious nature, are particularly attractive targets for scammers. Whenever you encounter an email, text or phone call requesting money, gift cards or financial assistance, please remember the following rule: Stop, Consider and Con**firm**. **Stop**: Never be in a rush to respond or act. Consider: does this request seem credible? If you have the slightest doubt or hesitation it is probably a scam. Confirm: use an alternative means of communication to contact the purported source of the request and double check. And finally, remember this rule of thumb: Rev. Mike has NEVER has, and WOULD NEVER, make a direct request for money, gift cards or any financial help from a member of **the congregation**. Often times an email or text may say it is from Rev. Mike, but if you take a moment to look at the email address or text number it will be different than what you have in your address book. "I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves." -Matthew 10:16


